On April 19, 2002, the Copyright Office Board of Appeals received a second request for reconsideration of the Copyright Office's refusal to register the above listed works on behalf of your client. You had wanted the Office to see the works themselves, and we tried to accommodate you. That meeting has been postponed due to your client's illness.

The Board would like to close this appeal out. We can do that in one of 2 ways:

- Consider the request on the basis of the paper record and the deposit of identifying photographs of the works.
- 2) Consider the request on the basis of an alternate deposit. Should your client feel that the Board could better view the claimed copyrightable authorship in these works with a videotape of CD deposit, we would be glad to view that.

We would appreciate a response from you by no later than June 6, 2004.
