In answer to your fax of November 13 regarding a clarification of Paragraph 5, a, iii, of your contract with the Society, "reference selects" refers to relatively low-quality dupes made of a selection of transparencies made on the Society's assignment. These "reference selects" are retained in the Society's Illustrations Library and the originals of these images are returned to the photographer.

These dupes are, as the contract states, retained for reference only. The mounts are so marked and, in fact, the quality of the dupe is usually not high enough to permit reproduction in Society publications. The Illustrations Library is often a first source for photographs for numerous Society publications -- primarily book and educational media projects. These "reference selects," in addition to most of the published photographs which are retained in the library, gives a basis on which the Illustrations Editors can draw to determine which photographs are available for their individual projects.

In any case, should an Illustrations Editor desire to consider further any material represented in the Illustrations Library as a "reference select," the original transparency is requested from the photographer. It is then, obviously, up to the individual photographer as to whether he or she wishes to provide the original transparency.


- A. I am aware of the high quality images that can be stored on this type of system.

Therefore, I believe that you will only get their attention with facts and threats. Can you go back through your contracts and see if you ever gave them permission to keep images as "file selects?" Do you see any situations where you agreed to their holding onto anything for later use? Are all circumstances where they have your images a violation of your exclusive-rights contracts? Are you sure that you have never granted them the contractual right to hold onto anything of yours?

Once that is determined, your attorney could write a letter to the NGS attorney saying you believe that material of yours is being held against your will and without authorization. He could insist on a full accounting from all departments, including the library, the video disc operation, books, special pubs, the magazine, TV, etc., and within a fixed time period forward that list to you.

With that information you can determine what you want to do in order to protect your rights. Obviously the only way they can continue using your material without asking for permission up front is that they are already holding copies of it. Force them to disclose where every piece of film or digital file is of your material. I believe you (and all the rest of us) will be amazed at the extent of the copying.

Thank you for your letter of October 5th.

The reason that I did not want to hear from Win Scudder is that I believe that various members of the National Geographic editorial and illustration departments have a problem of using the intellectual properties of non-staffers without permission in the many publications of the Society. I had hoped that by contacting you directly, I would be able to have someone at the corporate counsel level to help me address this problem. Apparently, I have failed.

In my first discussion with you in mid September, I did mention that I was paid the \$750.00 but could not get the satisfaction of having the duplicates of my copyrighted material returned to me. The request for the return of this material was made back in March of 1994. It took over six months to have this material returned to me and this was done after having a discussion with you.

The problem was never about the \$750.00. That was taken care of very quickly. My problem was the ethics of using my material without my permission. This was not the first time that this has happened.

Please be advised that I am in the process of retaining appropriate counsel to address this issue.

This is a follow-up of our discussion that began in February 29, 1996 concerning the marketing of my "Reference Select" (NGS ID RFP105F32, my ID-5783-074).

I trust you will recall and note that I stated in February and now state again that I declined and still decline permission for the Society to act as my photo agent.

On June 14, 1989 I signed an agreement with Kent Kobersteen for the Pennekamp Reef Park story #05738. It stated in Paragraph 5 (a-iii) that NGS may take and retain, in its illustrations libraries, copies of some of the photographs as "Reference Selects" only.

On November 16, 1989, I asked for clarification of what "Reference Selects" meant. Mr. Kobersteen advised me that the "Illustrations Library is often a first source for photographs for numerous Society publications. "Reference Selects" means to me what Mr. Kobersteen told me it meant to him.

NGS was not then in the photo agency business. Had I known the Society had plans to go into that business, I never would have accepted those terms.

Formerly, the Society forwarded outside queries directly to me. We have no agreement beyond that. The Society cannot alter the terms of our agreement unilaterally. It is NOT acceptable to me for the Society to act as my photo agent and to offer my material to outside clients.

It will be mutually beneficial at this time to review which of my photographs are in your Permanent Collection, in the Illustrations Library and in the NGS Image Collection. You should know that most of my work is copyrighted by me. In order to avoid costly mistakes where my work appeared in print against my wishes and in violation of my copyrights, I believe the Society should take steps now to protect its own interests as well as mine. I want an inventory of any and all images made by me that are held by the National Geographic in any form, including originals, duplicates, digital files, electronic products, etc.



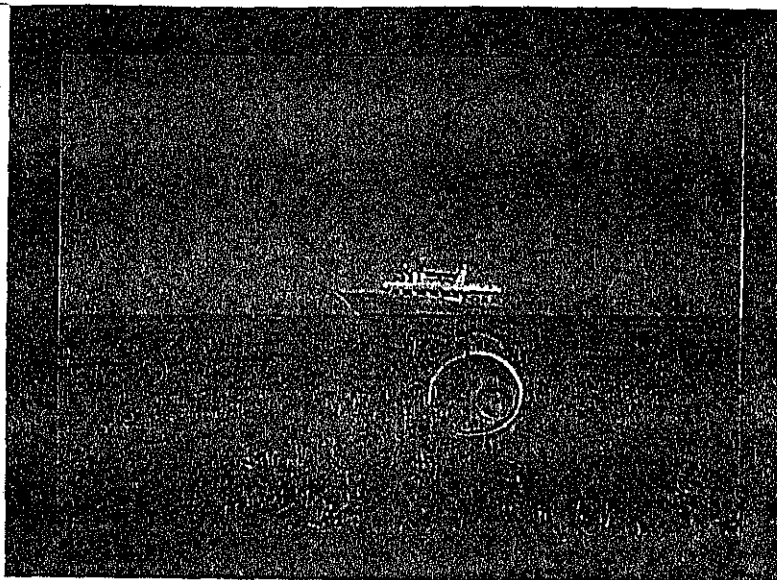

Dear Ms Nolan:

This is a follow-up of our discussion that began in February 29, 1996 concerning the marketing of my "Reference Select" (NGS ID RFP105F32, my ID-5783-074).

I trust you will recall and note that I stated in February and now state again that I declined and still decline permission for the Society to act as my photo agent.

On June 14, 1989 I signed an agreement with Kent Kobersteen for the Pennekamp Reef Park story #05738. It stated in Paragraph 5 (a-iii) that NGS may take and retain, in its illustrations libraries, copies of some of the photographs as "Reference Selects" only.

On November 16, 1989, I asked for clarification of what "Reference Selects" meant. Mr. Kobersteen advised me that the "Illustrations Library is often a first source for photographs for numerous Society publications. "Reference Selects" means to me what Mr. Kobersteen told me it meant to him.

NGS was not then in the photo agency business. Had I known the Society had plans to go into that business, I never would have accepted those terms.

Formerly, the Society forwarded outside queries directly to me. We have no agreement beyond that. The Society cannot alter the terms of our agreement unilaterally. It is NOT acceptable to me for the Society to act as my photo agent and to offer my material to outside clients.

It will be mutually beneficial at this time to review which of my photographs are in your Permanent Collection, in the Illustrations Library and in the NGS Image Collection. You should know that most of my work is copyrighted by me. In order to avoid costly mistakes where my work appeared in print against my wishes and in violation of my copyrights, I believe the Society should take steps now to protect its own interests as well as mine. I want an inventory of any and all images made by me that are held by the National Geographic in any form, including originals, duplicates, digital files, electronic products, etc.
