**INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY IN CENTRAL/EASTERN EUROPE:
DEVELOPMENTS AND DIRECTIONS**

A luncheon meeting with Professor Karl F. Jorda of Franklin Pierce Law Center, speaking on "Intellectual Property in Central/Eastern Europe: Developments and Directions".

Professor Jorda will share his insight regarding recent developments in the intellectual property laws of Central and Eastern European countries, including Albania, Bulgaria, Romania, the former Yugoslavia, the former Soviet Union/Commonwealth of Independent States, Czech and Slovak Federal Republics, Hungary and Poland.

Professor Jorda is currently the David Rines Professor of Intellectual Property Law and Industrial Innovation and Director, Kenneth J. Germeshausen Center for the Law of Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Franklin Pierce Law Center, Concord, New Hampshire. Professor Jorda has served as a consultant for WIPO, as well as foreign governments in various capacities. He has headed several delegations of U.S. Patent Council to Japanese Patent Office meetings, and has participated in WIPO symposia in Mongolia, Korea, Indonesia, India and Russia. Professor Jorda has also been a visiting scholar at the Max-Planck Institute for Foreign and International Patent, Copyright and Competition Laws, and has served as an Observer for PIPA and NYPTC at WIPO-Paris Convention Revision and Patent Law Harmonization Meetings in Nairobi and Geneva.
