ENCRYPTION LICENSE EXCEPTION CHART

This chart identifies all license exceptions that are applicable to encryption items. It is not all inclusive and is meant only as initial guidance for exporters. For additional information, please refer to the appropriate sections of Part 740 of the Export Administration Regulations to ascertain other provisions, criteria and restrictions of each license exception.

ENC - 740.17(b)(1)	Encryption Items (includes technology)	U.S. Subsidiaries (Includes foreign nationals)	Global, except the T-7	Yes - only when transferred outside the U.S. subsidiary	- No review prior to export - Review is required for items to be reexported, resold or transferred

ENC - 740.17(b)(4)(ii)	Commercial source code ("proprietary")	All, except foreign governments	Global, except the T-7	Yes	- Self-classify and submit classification request - Export immediately
ENC - 740.17(b)(5)	Products that contain an Open Cryptographic Interfaces	All	Located in EU+8 (see Supp. 3 to Part 740)	Yes	- May export immediately - Review and classification by BXA - Licenses are required to all other destinations outside EU+8
