*Committee on the Judiciary:* Subcommittee No. 3 in executive session ordered favorably reported to the full committee H. R. 6716 (amended), relating to actions for infringements of copyrights by the United States. In a preliminary hearing the subcommittee considered H. R. 10617, to amend title 18, United States Code, section 3651, so as to permit confinement in jail-type institutions or treatment institutions for a period not exceeding 6 months in connection with the grant of probation on a 1-count indictment. Witnesses heard were Judge Richard Hartshorne, U. S. district judge, Newark, N. J., and Louis J. Sharp, Chief of Probation in the Administrative Office, U. S. Courts.
