EFFECTIVENESS OF PATENT
LAWS

Mr. BAKER. Mr. President, I ask that the Chair lay before the Senate a message from the House of Representatives on H.R. 6286.

The PRESIDING OFFICER laid before the Senate the following message from the House of Representatives:

Resolved, That the House agree to the amendments of the Senate numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, and 9 to the bill (H.R. 6286) entitled "An Act to amend title 35, United States Code, to increase the effectiveness of the patent laws, and for other purposes."

Resolved, That the House agree to the amendment of the Senate numbered 6 to the aforesaid bill, with the following amendment:

Strike out the matter stricken and the matter proposed to be inserted by said amendment.
