TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO
 THE FEDERAL COURTS IM-
 PROVEDMENT ACT OF 1982

Mr. BAKER. Mr. President, it is certainly not a mark of ingratitude on my part to ask now, What is the pending business?

The PRESIDING OFFICER. H.R. 4222.

Mr. BAKER. Mr. President, I am prepared to proceed with that.

The amendment by the Senator from Tennessee [Mr. SASSER], has that amendment been adopted?

The PRESIDING OFFICER. That amendment has been agreed to.

Mr. BAKER. And the bill itself has not yet been adopted?

The PRESIDING OFFICER. The Senator is correct.

Are there further amendments?

Mr. BYRD. Mr. President, the Senator to whom I alluded earlier as having perhaps an amendment to the bill is here and it is my understanding that he does not intend to pursue that.

The PRESIDING OFFICER. Are there further amendments? If not, the question is on the engrossment of the amendment and third reading of the bill.

The amendment was ordered to be engrossed and the bill to be read a third time.

The bill was read the third time.

The PRESIDING OFFICER. The bill having been read the third time, the question is, Shall it pass?

The bill (H.R. 4222) was passed.

Mr. BAKER. Mr. President, I move to reconsider the vote by which the bill was passed.

Mr. RIEGLE. I move to lay that motion on the table.

The motion to lay on the table was agreed to.
