AFFIDAVIT OF EDWARD FINKEL

EDWARD FINKEL, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1) That he is Vice-President of JFD Electronics Corp., 15th Avenue at 62nd Street, Brooklyn, New York, 11219, a manufacturer of radio and television antennas;

2) That under the terms of the License Agreement with the University of Illinois Foundation entered into on December 1, 1965, JFD Electronics Corp. holds an exclusive license under United States Patent No. 3,210,767 only in the field of receiving antennas for television and FM broadcasting stations and antennas for amateur and citizen band transmission and reception, excerpts from said agreement being attached hereto as Exhibit A, with appropriate deletions to remove material of a confidential business nature only;

3) Under the terms of the agreement with the University of Illinois Foundation, JFD Electronics Corp. has the right to sue for infringement of the licensed patent only in the event that the Foundation fails to do so after request by JFD (Exhibit A, Paragraph 14).


Further, in the event that suit is instituted by the Foundation at JFD's request in accordance with the contract, JFD thereafter has no residual action for infringement or claim for damages against the accused infringer arising from its accused infringement of the aforementioned licensed patent; and

4) That the above-identified action by the University of Illinois Foundation against Blonder-Tongue Laboratories, Inc. et al was instituted at the request of JFD Electronics Corp. pursuant to its agreement with the University of Illinois Foundation.
