PROPOSED JUDGMENT ORDER

This cause having been considered upon the pleadings,
evidence and briefs by counsel for the parties,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

1. Patent 3,210,767 and Re.25,740 are invalid and unenforceable.
2. Defendant, Blonder-Tongue Laboratories, Inc., has not infringed patents 3,210,767 and Re.25,740, if they were valid.
3. The Complaint be dismissed with prejudice.

4. Patent 3,259,904 is valid and claim 5 thereof has been infringed by Counterclaim Defendant, JFD Electronics Corporation, and Plaintiff, University of Illinois Foundation.

5. Counterclaim Defendant, JFD Electronics Corporation, and Plaintiff, University of Illinois Foundation, are guilty of unfair competition and antitrust violation.

6. This case is hereby referred to _____, who is hereby appointed Special Master of this Court, for the purpose of ascertaining and reporting the damages incurred by Defendant, Blonder-Tongue Laboratories, Inc., by reason of the patent infringement, unfair competition and anti-trust violations of Counterclaim Defendant, JFD Electronics Corporation, and Plaintiff, University of Illinois Foundation.

7. Counterclaim Defendant, JFD Electronics Corporation, and Plaintiff, University of Illinois Foundation, are hereby enjoined from further infringement of patent 3,259,904 and from further acts of unfair competition or antitrust violation.
