

9 on which the Court executes this order. The parties shall disclose
10 the information requested by Interrogatory No. 9 simultaneously.

11 3. If necessary, either party shall supplement its
12 responses to Interrogatory No. 9 before the Pre-Trial Conference in
13 this action set for December 13, 1984.
