Question: Adequacy of notice

The full title of this work appears on the cover. On the first page of the text also is printed the full title and on the back of this page - i.e., page (4) - is printed the copyright notice in the full statutory form.

It is the opinion of Mr. Wise and Mr. Smith that the first page of text upon which the full title has been printed may be considered the title page and, the notice of copyright appearing on the back thereof, registration should be made.

On the other hand, Mrs. Brady feels that the cover is the title page and the first page of text upon which the title is repeated is not in fact the title page contemplated by the Statute and, therefore, the copyright notice being misplaced, the application must be rejected.
