Question: Adequacy of copyright notice

The copies of the works deposited consist of large envelopes, the front of which is of cellophane. Under this appear cut-out figure drawings and a printed leaflet bearing the title with several designs and the copyright notice. On the back of the envelopes is pasted a small sheet of text matter which includes a number of statements and the directions for using the material. It is the opinion of Mr. Wise and Mr. Smith that registration should be made for this material as applied for. On the other hand, Mrs. Rafter feels that the notice of copyright on the printed slip which appears through the cellophane cover is inadequate, and that the notice of copyright should have been applied on the printed title and directions page on the back of the envelope.
