
Title: "The Little Horn or Trumpet of God" and "To the Waters."

Question: Division of opinion as to whether separate registration should be required for two poems mimeographed on separate sheets of paper and clipped together.

Applicant has filed an application for registration giving in space (6) the titles of both poems. The copies consist of two mimeographed sheets, one poem on each sheet and the sheets fastened together by means of two clips. There is no general title to cover both poems. The Office conducted correspondence suggesting that separate registration would better be made for each under its own title. Correspondent has replied that the material is distributed as a single publication in this form and urges registration.

In the opinion of Mr. Wise and Mr. Smith the Office is obliged to make registration as applied for. On the other hand, Mrs. Brady and Mr. Pierce feel that the Office should insist upon separate applications.
