
Title: "Heavenly Glory Songs."

Question: Division of opinion as to whether registration can be made on form E1 for a collection of musical compositions including a large number of compositions published for the first time.

The application has been filed on form E1 for a republished musical composition with new matter. In the space of the application provided for the statement of new matter the titles of the new musical compositions included in the collection are listed.

In the opinion of Mr. Wise and Mr. Smith registration should be made as applied for. The application clearly states the new matter in the collection which is subject matter of copyright. Mrs. Brady, on the other hand, takes the position that each of the musical compositions included in the collection bearing a 1940 copyright notice should be registered for copyright under its own title. The collection as a whole she feels may be registered on form E.
