
Title: "Pneumothorax Directory"

Question: Location of copyright notice.

The first seventeen pages of the book consist of listings of the names of the officials, committees, key to numerals and statement of membership, and objectives, and index of volume. On page eighteen is to be found the Introduction, immediately beneath which appears the copyright notice. The following page, page 19, commences the directory itself, headed by the title of the work "Pneumothorax Directory." The only other part of the book which might be considered the title-page ~~than page 19~~ would be the cover of the book, upon which appears the title "Pneumothorax Directory."

Mrs. Brady and Mr. McCarteney are of the opinion that the copyright notice should have been placed upon the front cover or inside the front cover and that its present position on page 18 is not conformity with the statute. Mr. Smith, however, feels that in view of the fact that the directory does not actually commence until page 19 and the title of the work appears in large letters at the head of page 19 that that page can be considered the title-page of the work, and that hence the copyright notice is in a position sufficiently close to the title-page so as to comply with the intent of the statute.
