
Remitter: H. E. Vroman (MP-2349)

Title: "On Guard"

Question: "Is registration in order where only some published copies bore the copyright notice?"

The Minority does not feel that the remitter has made a case for himself and he merely evaded the question of publication with copyright notice. He admits in the postcard received July 15, 1944 that not all of the photos bore a notice. In view of the second paragraph of the Copyright Office letter of July 31, 1944 and the remitter's statement "to put this through or return my two prints and one dollar" it is the opinion of the Minority that the work should be rejected and fee refunded.
