## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

To correct technical errors in the enrollment of the bill S. 1538.

1 Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives concurring), That, in the enrollment of the bill (S. 1538) to 2 amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to revise 3 4 the procedures for new drug applications, to amend title 35, 5 United States Code, to authorize the extension of the patents for certain regulated products, and for other purposes, the 6 Secretary of the Senate shall make the following changes. In 7 sections 505(j)(4)(B)(iii)(III) and 505(c)(3)(C)(iii) of the Feder-8 al Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act as added by sections 101 9 and 103(b) of the bill, respectively, strike out "not invalid" 10 and insert in lieu thereof "invalid". 11
