STEVENSON-WYDLER TECHNOLOGY INNOVATION ACT AMENDMENTS

Mr. DOLE. Mr. President, I ask that the Chair lay before the Senate a message from the House of Representatives on H.R. 3773.

The PRESIDING OFFICER laid before the Senate the following message from the House of Representatives:

Resolved, That the House disagree to the amendments of the Senate to the bill (H.R. 3773) entitled "An Act to amend the Stevenson-Wydler Technology Innovation Act of 1980 to promote technology transfer by authorizing Government-operated laboratories to enter into cooperative research agreements and by establishing a Federal Laboratory Consortium for Technology Transfer within the National Science Foundation, and for other purposes", and ask a conference with the Senate on the disagreeing votes of the two Houses thereon.

Ordered, That Mr. Fuqua, Mr. Walgren, Mr. Lundine, Mr. Lujan, and Mr. Boehlert be the managers of the conference on the part of the House.

Mr. DOLE. Mr. President, I move that the Senate insist on its amendments and agree to the conference requested by the House and that the Chair be authorized to appoint conferees on the part of the Senate.

The motion was agreed to, and the Presiding Officer appointed Mr. DANFORTH, Mr. GORTON, Mr. PRESSLER, Mr. HOLLINGS, and Mr. RIEGLE conferees on the part of the Senate.
