## AN ACT

Providing for the extension of patent numbered D-119,187.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That (a) a certain design patent issued by the United States  
4        Patent Office of date February 27, 1940, being patent num-  
5        bered D-119,187, which is the insignia of the Massachusetts  
6        Department of the United American Veterans of the United  
7        States of America, Incorporated, is hereby renewed and  
8        extended for an additional period of fourteen years from and  
9        after the date of enactment of this Act, with all the rights  
10       and privileges pertaining to the same, being generally  
11       known as the insignia of the Massachusetts Department

1 of the United American Veterans of the United States of  
2 America, Incorporated; (b) no person who has manufac-  
3 tured the design of such patent between February 27, 1954,  
4 and the date of the enactment of this Act shall be held liable  
5 for infringement of such patent by reason of the continued  
6 manufacture and sale thereof.
