A BILL

To authorize an increase in the membership of the Board of Appeals of the Patent Office; to provide increased salaries for certain officers and employees of the Patent Office; and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) the first sentence of the first paragraph of section
4 3 of title 35 of the United States Code is amended by strik-
5 ing out the word "nine" and inserting in lieu thereof the
6 words "not more than fifteen."

7 ~~(b) The fourth sentence of such paragraph is repealed.~~

8 ~~(c)~~ (b) Such section is amended by inserting therein,

1 immediately after the first paragraph thereof, the following
2 new paragraph:

3 “The annual basic rate of compensation of the Com-
4 missioner shall be ~~\$20,500~~ \$20,000; that of the first assistant
5 commissioner shall be \$20,000; and that of each assistant
6 commissioner shall be \$19,500. The Commissioner is
7 authorized, without regard to the provisions of the Classifica-
8 tion Act of 1949, as amended, to fix the annual rates of
9 basic compensation of the examiners-in-chief, *subject to the*
10 *approval of the Civil Service Commission*, at rates not ex-
11 ceeding the maximum rate now or hereafter prescribed by
12 law for employees of the classes described in the first section
13 of the Act entitled ‘An Act to authorize the creation of
14 additional positions in the professional and scientific service
15 in the War and Navy Departments,’ approved August 1,
16 1947 (61 Stat. 715), as amended. The Commissioner is
17 authorized, in accordance with the civil service laws and the
18 Classification Act of 1949, as amended, to appoint, fix the
19 compensation, and prescribe the powers and duties of all
20 other officers and employees of the Patent Office.”

21 SEC. 2. Section 7 of title 35 of the United States Code
22 is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new
23 sentence: “The Commissioner is authorized, without regard
24 to the Classification Act of 1949, as amended, to fix the
25 annual rate of basic compensation of any acting examiner-

1 ~~in chief who is designated under this paragraph to serve as~~
2 ~~an examiner-in-chief at any rate not in excess of that~~
3 ~~authorized by law for examiners-in-chief while such acting~~
4 ~~examiner-in-chief is so serving."~~ *Such designated exam-*
5 *iners-in-chief may be compensated at the established rate for*
6 *the positions in which they are temporarily serving, provided,*
7 *that at the end of the period for which designated their rate*
8 *of compensation shall be adjusted to what it would have been*
9 *had such designation not been made."*
